EXHIBITORS IN THIS SECTION PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Ensure that you have read the Society Rules, privacy and Health & Safety Statements.
- 2. Entry forms to be sent to:

- 3. Closing date for entries 14th July 2024.
- 4. In exceptional circumstances, late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Secretary subject to an additional penalty charge of 20p per exhibit.
- 5. No entries on the day.
- Entries of £6 or more from an individual child exhibitor will entitle the exhibitor to one
 complimentary exhibitor admission ticket. Posting of exhibitor tickets cannot be guaranteed for
 late entries.
- 7. All exhibits must be staged by 10.00 am. Exhibits may be removed no earlier than 4.30 pm.
- 8. In 2024, all classes are defined as Open Classes.
- 9. Prize money will be paid from **3.30pm** onwards from the Produce Tent. Trophy winners will be asked for proof of identity when collecting trophies from the Secretarys Tent.
- 10. Each Trophy shall be held for one year under a guarantee that it will be delivered to the Trophy Secretary, 5 weeks before the Show in good condition, new engraving completed and that in the event of its loss or damage the appropriate amount of its value or repair to be made good to the Secretary by the holder.
- 11. All work must be the original work or produce of the exhibitor, and not have been shown at Weeton Show previously.
- 12. Exhibitors should ensure that garments/exhibits are clean and unworn.
- 13. When allocating trophies for most points gained, points will be awarded as follows: 1st place- 3 points; 2nd place- 2 points; 3rd place- 1 point.
- 14. Wherever appropriate, please present entries in a protective plastic sleeve or laminate them for protection against adverse weather.
- 15. Please copy out the poem by hand (in script or natural handwriting) on one or more sheets of LINED OR UNLINED paper, size A4 or A5, as suitable. (Age to be shown on the back of exhibit).

HANDWRITING: THE MARGARET CLAPHAM TROPHY will be awarded to the overall winner in this handwriting section, with special consideration given to the age of competitors.

CRAFTS – PAINTING & DRAWING: THE MAURICE JONES TROPHY, kindly presented by Dr DMH Jones, will be awarded to the competitor with the best entry in the children's painting and drawing classes, with special consideration given to the ages of the competitors.

ANYTHING HANDMADE AT HOME: THE LINDA TURNELL CHILDREN'S TROPHY will be awarded to the overall winner in classes P56 to P60 with special consideration given to the age of the competitors.

WOODEN SPOON BOOK CHARACTER: THE HARTLEY CARR TROPHY will be awarded to the overall winner in classes P61 to P64 with special consideration given to age of the competitors.

CERAMIC PAINTING: THE F CUSK CUP, kindly presented to the Society by F Cusk will be awarded to the competitor with the best entry in classes P65 - P69B, with special consideration given to the age of competitors.

CHILDRENS COOKERY: THE LIZ FORD CHILDREN'S TROPHY will be awarded to the competitor with the best entry in classes P73 to P75, with special consideration given to the ages of the competitors.

AN ARRANGEMENT IN AN UNUSAUL CONTAINER: THE WENDY HOUSE CUP will be awarded to the competitor with the most points in classes P76 to P80.

WEETON SHOW PROMOTIONAL POSTER COMPETITION: A Keepsake Trophy will be awarded to the winner.
