- H9 6 shallots dressed
- H10 3 onions from sets with tops
- H11 4 tomatoes
- H11A 6 cherry tomatoes
- H12 1 vegetable marrow
- H13 1 cucumber
- H14 1 lettuce
- H15 3 beetroot, tops trimmed to 75mm
