

WEETON SHOW 20th JULY 2026 - TRADE STAND TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Public Liability Insurance of at least £5million is required. Please enclose a copy of your current certificate along with any equipment testing certificates (if applicable). Without these your booking request will not be considered.
2. If you are proposing to use a generator, please contact the Trade Stand Secretary first for approval. Generators must be sited away from areas accessible to show visitors and must not interfere with other traders. Risk assessments and method statements are required for all traders, attractions and rides and should be provided with the application. Without these, bookings will not be accepted.
3. The 'description of goods to be sold' must be adhered to. The Society reserves the right to refuse entry to, or seek removal from, the show if this is not the case.
4. Spaces and/or pitches cannot be guaranteed until your application form, enclosures and payment for the correct amount is provided along with an email address for a receipt, entry tickets and Trade Stand vehicle pass to be issued.
5. Every vehicle must display a pass.
6. The Trade Stand Secretary will assign a pitch for you on the show field in accordance with this completed form, you will be expected to stay within the limits of this space otherwise obstructions can be caused to others.
7. Pitches are allocated on a first come first served basis and the deadline for pitches will be 1st June 2026. We reserve the right to return your bank transfer and decline application if we already have a number of pitches selling/exhibiting similar products.
8. The Trade Stand Secretary reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show field due to late arrival, misrepresentation of goods and any further breach of this agreement and conditions.
9. Stallholders must ensure their gazebos or tents are securely pegged.
10. The Society reserves the right to amend the total cost of pitch and/or stall if the customer's calculations are incorrect.
11. This application is not transferable under any circumstances.
12. Stall holders are not permitted to use PA systems or loudhailers.
13. There is no water or electricity on the show field. Traders must bring sufficient for their needs.
14. Hygiene certificates to be submitted with the application where appropriate.
15. Pitches must be claimed before 8.30am on Sunday 19th July. **NO ENTRY TO THE SHOWFIELD WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER THIS TIME.** Please ensure you have adequate supplies for your stall.
16. Refund policy – in the unlikely event the Show Committee cancel the Show due to unforeseen circumstances, a full refund will be given or your application rolled over to our 2027 show. Otherwise no refunds will be given.
17. All Tickets and information, including your allocated site details, will be forwarded approximately 2 weeks prior to the Show.
